### **Short Description/Outline of the Programme:**


Parent-Teacher Meet was organized in Dr. Ambedkar College of Arts, Commerce & Science on Saturday, 7<sup>th</sup> August 2021 at 11.00 AM in online mode on Webex Meet App, to discuss about academic improvement and performance of the students with their parents and to make a healthy relationship amongst the students, parents and teachers. About 105 parents attended the meet virtually.


